

Then Owl went to the beach to find a pointy shell.


Owl painted Mucky with the cream and tied the pointy shell on his head.












In the morning, the cows got a surprise.






It started to rain hard.

The rain washed the cream away.








Everyone felt sad for Mucky.


"We will make more cream," the cows said. "Please don't cry."
